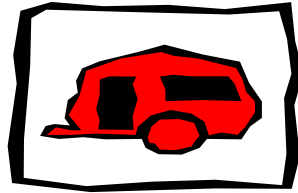


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CODE COMPLIANCE - Vehicles and RVs

AGCC Board Members Chuck Sachse and Terri Lattman along with Chuck Oursler of Realty Headquarters recently met with Ida Ford, Senior Land Development Investigator, Neighborhood Code Compliance with the City of San Diego. We know that a lot of residents of Allied Gardens and Grantville have concerns about vehicles, RVs, motor homes and storage units that are parked on our streets and in yards.



Notes taken by AGCC Board Member Terri Lattman at the meeting include:

- A motor home can be parked in a driveway, but cannot overhang “public right of way”. (“Property line” might be within lawn or driveway area).
- A trailer or storage container cannot be parked in front of a garage door without allowing access of a car to the garage.
- RV’s parked on a street must be moved every 72 hours. If this is not taking place, call the police parking enforcement, not code compliance.
- Storage containers can be on private property for the length of a construction permit.
- Pods can be on private property for 30 days without a permit. An active building permit is required after that time period.
- Cars must be on “pavement”.
- Contact a City Community Planner or your area’s city councilperson to change a Code Compliance law.
